KEY CITY DEVELOPMENT ISSUES

The overall city's development plans focus on the following areas:

In line with the City Strategic Development Plan (2009-2015) the city aims at improving its performance in the delivery of key urban services including the improvement of i) water supply network ii) sewerage and drainage system, and iii) solid waste management.

In addition, the city is looking at increasing its support to low income areas through a comprehensive plan that aims at addressing the infrastructure needs of these communities.

DETAILS OF COOPERATION

CDIA supported activities include:

- a) Conduct a Pre-feasibility study addressing: water supply, sewerage and drainage issues in line with existing city priority areas;
- b) Linkage of the Pre-feasibility study with potential financiers; and
- c) Assist the city in strengthening its own capacity for improved infrastructure provision.

EXPECTED DEVELOPMENTAL IMPACTS

- Improved living conditions through improved drainage, water supply and waste water treatment.
- Improved living conditions for significant part of the population through improved drainage and reduced flooding.
