KEY CITY DEVELOPMENT ISSUES

The overall city's development plans focus on the following areas:

The public transportation sector in Peshawar has been neglected over the past few decades, with no investment placed to develop it in contrast with the rapid construction of roads and flyovers in the City. The decline in traffic conditions on key arterials has reached the situation of manageable for the limited resources available. In addition, existing private public transportation is the only travel options available to the poor population in Peshawar, and it is not easily accessible, reliable and with no safety measures imposed. This deteorating situation prompted to the demand to introduce mass rapid transits such as Bus Rapid Transit (BRT) and Metro rail. The Government of Khyber Pakhtunkhwa has taken the decision to priorities public transport and made it part of the Comprehensive Development Strategy (CDS).

DETAILS OF COOPERATION

CDIA supported activities include:

- a) Develop a 20-year Public Transport Strategy with a complementary 10-year Action plan for Peshawar public transportation system, highlighting the financial feasibility, environmental and social impact as well as sustainability of the Peshawar Rapid Transit (PRT).
- b) Preparation of the Pre-Feasibility Study (PFS) for urban transport options, which assess the technical, financial feasibility and management of rapid transit options as well as rail based system for Peshawar
- c) Recommendation on implementation and operational arrangement for the urban transport system including potential for PPP

EXPECTED DEVELOPMENTAL IMPACTS

- Improve public transport service reliability, work efficiency, and safety,
- Increase mobility and accessibility to public transport particularly for the poor population, elderly and disabled residents
- Job creation through training and regular employment, and increase employment opportunities for women
- Potentially reduce emission of CO2 by approximately 12,500kgs annually over the 20 year assessment period
