While the CIIPP is suitable for application across all Asian cities, it is most effective when local legal, financial, environmental, social, and institutional factors are clearly understood and can be entered into the model.

To date, the toolkit has been customized for China, India, Vietnam, Indonesia, Cambodia and Nepal, with other versions in progress.

TOOLKIT COMPONENTS

The toolkit has three components:

- 1 Analysis of a city's financial capacity
- 2 Project definition and prioritization
- 3 Project packaging

THE PROCESS

The CIIPP model utilizes a four-step process to deliver a final output with each step generating a deliverable that provides the input for the next analysis stage.
