**KEY CITY DEVELOPMENT ISSUES**

In recent years, the demand for vocational education in China and in Guizhou province, has risen sharply. Before the year of 2007, there was no systematic Vocational Trainings in Guiyang city. Guiyang is in urgent need to improve the condition of educational services, in particular the vocational education services. The biggest problems that GVTC is facing on the improvement of those educational services includes:

- 1) Vocational education quality and investment is not adequate.
- 2) Education facilities and conditions are poor.
- 3) Inadequate training capacity.

The college has 10,604 full-time students, but only 540 teaching staff. Teaching staffs are insufficient with most of them having academic profile. Also, the technical trainings provided can't keep up with technology and practices in the actual industry.
